The Yale New Haven Center for Emergency Preparedness and Disaster Response (YNH-CEPDR), established post-9/11 by Yale New Haven Health System, is a national leader in developing and delivering assessment, planning, education and training, and exercise programs and services that support coordinated emergency preparedness and response for healthcare and other organizations.

YNH-CEPDR uses a course development/delivery and learning management system (LMS) developed by the Yale University Web Services Group.

The Yale-New Haven team was faced with the issues of converting existing online courses to SCORM conformant courses for use within multiple Learning Management Systems (LMS). The choices were to recreate the courses or find a conversion solution.
